THE PROBLEM

Each year, government child protection agencies are alerted to more than 7 million children who have allegedly experienced maltreatment. These reports have lead to over 400,000 children being removed from their homes and placed in an overburdened foster care system.

Any amount of time that a child spends in foster care is traumatic and increases their risk for devastating outcomes later in life. But it's not abuse that's causing the most disruption within families, but rather, neglect related to poverty.

THE SOLUTION

For many of these children, meeting a practical need at precisely the right moment can be the critical difference between a child remaining stable at home with their family or being separated from everyone and everything familiar to them.

An abundance of local churches, organizations, and caring people are positioned in every community with both the desire and resources to meet those needs and effectively reverse this detrimental problem. Our platform connects these communities to care together — in real-time, to unleash and amplify the collective impact they can achieve for kids.

STEP 1 Uncovering Needs

STEP 2 Submitting Needs



The caseworker vets and types needs into CarePortal

STEP 3 Sharing Needs



CarePortal alerts nearby churches and community members to needs

STEP 4 Meeting Needs



Churches and community members partner to ensure that the child and family is helped



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
