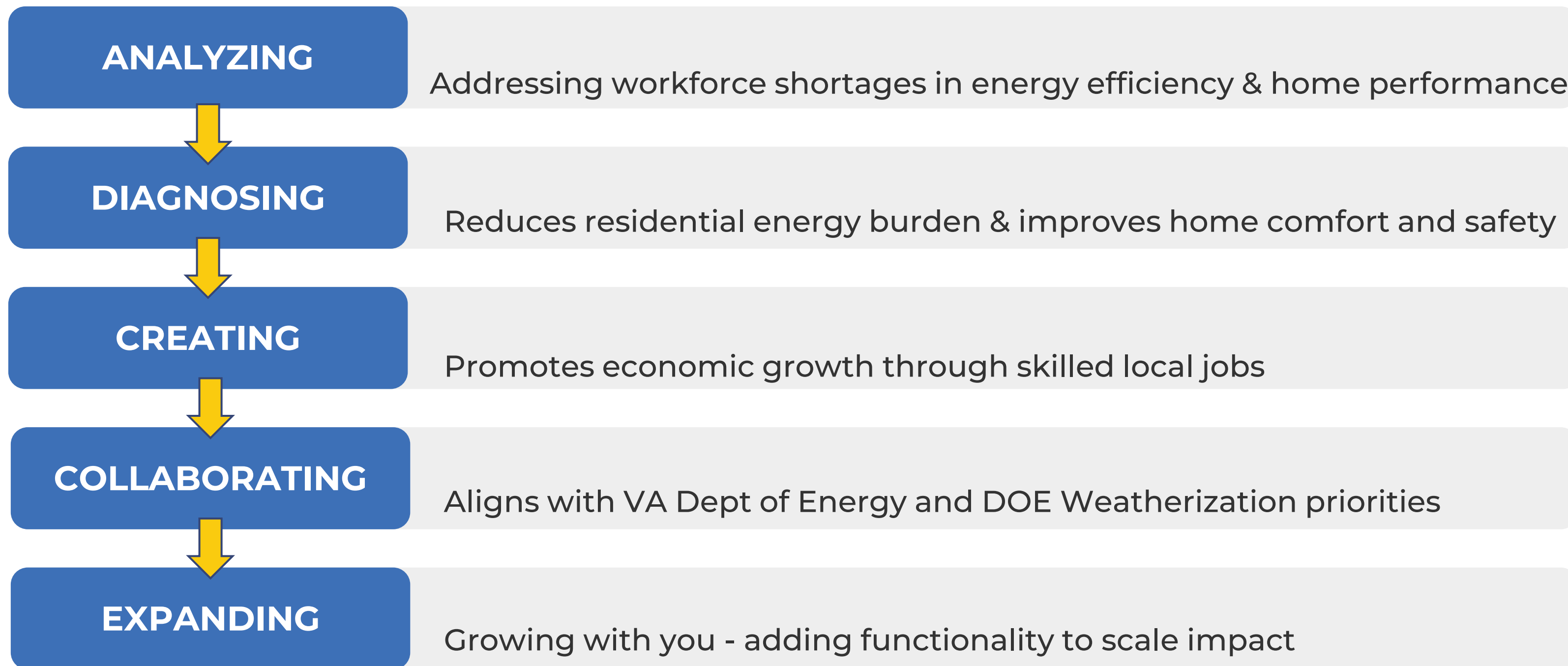

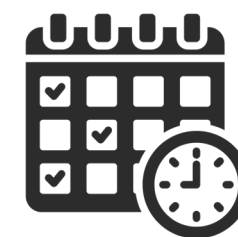

- ✓ On-the-Job Training: 25 (free) residential energy audits completed
- ✓ Reporting: Dashboard & DOE-compliant closeout reports
- ✓ Equipment: Local access to auditing tools
