RE: STATEMENT REGARDING RUCKERSVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE

Mr. Catalano read the following statement from the Board of Supervisors:

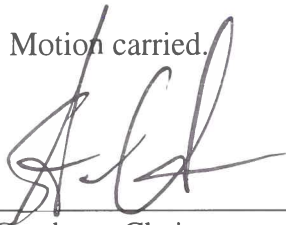
The Board of Supervisors' highest concern is for the safety of the public. The board took reasonable steps to protect the safety of the public by engaging a neutral, external review committee comprised of a deputy chief of Spotsylvania County Department of Fire Rescue and emergency management, a deputy chief of Louisa County Fire and EMS, and a battalion chief from the Fredericksburg Fire Department to review recent events that cause concern for public safety and the safety of firefighters. The next step will be a prompt meeting with the three fire companies to review recommendations and action items. The full after-action review, as well as other supporting documentation, will be forthcoming shortly. The board is eager to work with all three volunteer fire departments, fire companies, to implement these recommendations for the benefit of the public and the fire companies.

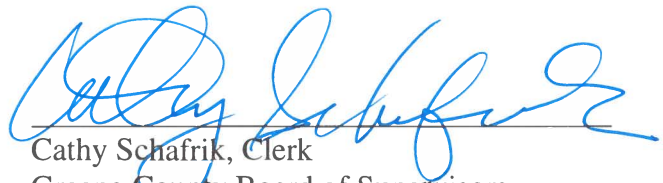
